

REVIEW: Rounding Multi-Digit Whole Numbers

Key Concept and Vocabulary



Visual Model

Round to the *nearest thousand*.



6,849 is closer to 7,000 than to 6,000. So, 6,849 rounds to 7,000.

Skill Examples

- **1.** To the *nearest thousand:* 11,486 rounds to 11,000.
- **2.** To the *nearest ten thousand:* 286,219 rounds to 290,000.
- **3.** To the *nearest hundred thousand:* 750,671 rounds to 800,000.

Application Example

4. 621,597 people vote in an election. To the nearest ten thousand, about how many people vote in the election?

To the *nearest ten thousand:* 621,597 rounds to 620,000.

About 620,000 people vote in the election.
