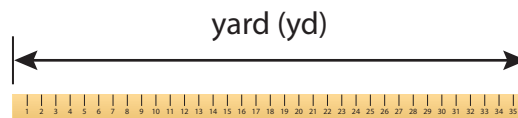

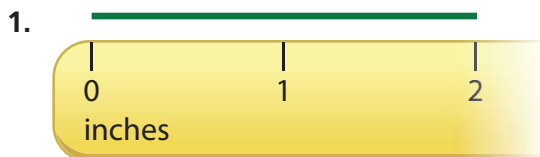


There are 12 inches in 1 foot.

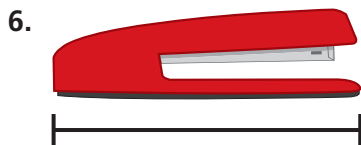
