20 drops of liquid from an eyedropper is about 1 milliliter.

There is about 1 liter of liquid in the water bottle.

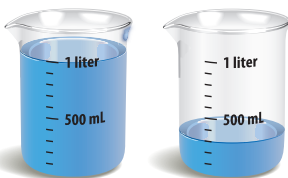
