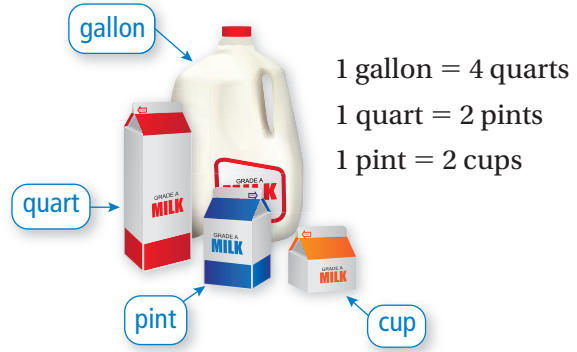
Key Concept and Vocabulary

Four customary units of capacity are cups (c), pints (pt), quarts (qt), and gallons (gal).

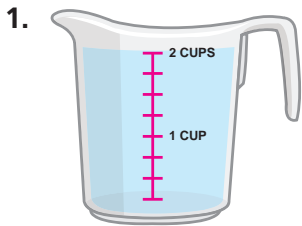
Customary capacity
